## CODE OF CONDUCT

We hope these guidelines will allow participants to feel at ease, create an enjoyable atmosphere for all, and maintain the facility for the entire community. The Center is committed to cultivating a culture of inclusiveness.

- Treat others with dignity, courtesy, civility and compassion.
- Obey all federal, state, county or city laws and ordinances.
- Do not bring into the Center dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons, or other similar items.
- Physical, sexual, or verbal harassment, stalking, and illegal actions will not be tolerated.
- Do not be under the influence of, possess, use, or sell alcohol or controlled substances.
- Tobacco use, vaping, and smoking are not allowed inside or directly outside of the building.
- Do not wear cosmetic fragrances.
- Caregivers must remain with their client while at the Center.
- Pets or animals other than service animals may not be brought into BISCC without prior permission of BISCC staff for purposes such as educational programming. Pets must be kept under control by their owner while the owner is participating in programs, taking advantage of services, or otherwise using the facilities.

Anyone violating a provision of this Code of Conduct will be asked to remedy the offense.

If the conduct is not remedied, the violator may be temporarily or permanently suspended from the Center and/or from participating in Center activities.

A person suspended from any Center activity will not be refunded any related registration fees.
